Here, crews from around the world will discover not only a spectacular and demanding race area, but also an authentic, welcoming region proud of its roots.





on the map) to park your trailer. Volunteers will be there to help you.




#### 30th August

The craning out order will be given on Friday, 29 August during the presentation of the day's prizes. It will be based on the ranking after 5 races.

Due to the Saturday morning market, the first 30 on the list will be invited to bring their trailers to the car park near the crane indicated on the general map (page 7) on <u>Friday evening</u>, to ensure that cranage operations start on time after the last race and run smoothly.
